Workshops

Several workshops will be facilitated throughout the day by various speakers. An opportunity to build our faith and our involvement in the Church.

◆ Youth ministry in the church

People will lead activities with children and explain how to share the Gospel in a dynamic way and adapted to the different ages of children.

◆ Youth: living my daily faith

A workshop for youth (from 13 years old) is intended to encourage them to have a passionate love for Jesus and to share their faith.

◆ Women's ministry

For women who want to encourage each other in their personal and spiritual development, and to develop dynamic women's groups in churches.

◆ Men's ministry

For all men who wish to share their faith together and be men living according to the will of God in their family, church and society.

◆ Developing Leadership Skills

How to become competent leaders who are listening to God and are models for others in our churches.

◆ History and specific aspects of the Free Methodist Church

As a member of the Methodist movement, what are our roots, our distinguishing characteristics that John Wesley suggested such as the means of grace, sanctification, etc.

◆ Having positive influence on evangelism

We will consider how to share the Gospel in the Quebec's context and with people of different cultures, while meeting their needs.

◆ Prayer and personal needs

A room will be available throughout the convention for prayer with others and to share personal needs.
